

## Need care right away?

If you have a minor condition that doesn't require an in-person medical exam, you may be able to save time using our new telephone appointment service. Just call to let us know what's wrong, and a Kaiser Permanente doctor will call you back within an hour. You can get great care—without leaving your home or work.

## Some examples of symptoms:\*

- Cold and coughs
- Sore Throat and toothaches
- Sinus and respiratory infections
- Nasal congestion
- Pink eye



Please note: You must be 18 years old or older to make a telephone appointment.

If you reasonably believe you have an emergency medical condition, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency department. An emergency medical condition is a medical or psychiatric condition that requires immediate medical attention to prevent serious jeopardy to your health. For the complete definition of an emergency medical condition, please refer to your *Evidence of Coverage*.



<sup>\*</sup>Telephone appointments are not appropriate for emergency conditions, such as severe shortness of breath, severe abdominal pain, severe bleeding, or urgent conditions—like sprains, falls, or cuts needing stitches.
