Jenedino Quinzon Memorial Scholarship Fund

Criteria to Apply

This scholarship is open to children of Family Health Center of San Diego (FHCS D) employees, dependents of FHCS D employees, FHCS D employees or partners/spouses. The scholarship fund will grant two, \$1000 scholarships each year, agency resources permitting. One award will be granted to an employee of FHCS D, and one to a dependent of a FHCS D employee. If insufficient qualified applications are received for one of the two categories, two awards may be rewarded to one category. Recipients must complete an application and provide all required information to substantiate eligibility. Failure to provide required information will render the application ineligible. Applicants may apply for four consecutive years. After a fourth year of funding, awardees will no longer be eligible.

Successful awardees must submit two reports during the year detailing academic progress. The reports must be submitted on the following schedule. Failure to submit reports will render the awardees ineligible for future funding.

Grants awards shall be used to further the applicants' study in any field of healthcare or any related health studies. The types of program may include 2-year colleges, 4-year colleges, technical or vocational training programs, ROP training or allied health programs. The specific course of study may include medicine, dentistry, optometry, medical office coursework, nursing, medical assisting, dental assisting, dental hygiene, speech pathology, audiology, occupational therapy, physical therapy, laboratory sciences, behavioral sciences or health education, case management, health information technology, healthcare accounting, medical administration, human resources in healthcare entities or social work.

All applications will be reviewed against established objective criteria. Establishing financial need and academic promise will be the primary focus of the Review Committee. Reviewers will be employees or board members of FHCS D. All decisions of the committee are final; no appeal rights will be extended to applicants. Declination of the committee does not preclude an applicant from applying the following year. If an applicant decides to defer education after the granting of the award and before commencing school, the applicant shall not receive the award and the applicant with the next highest score for that year will be awarded this scholarship.
